Background Information



Birmingham TreePeople is the city's charity for trees. We plant, promote and protect trees and our aim is to maximise the city's tree canopy cover.

We are excited to expand our work thanks to a grant from the National Lottery Community Fund. This funding is game changing for us and will enable us to employ a part time Operations Manager for 3 years.

For the last year we have employed an Engagement Lead and contracted with a self employed Communications Worker with project funding from the National Trust as part of the Urban Forest Accelerator. Both of these workers will continue in their roles from 1st September, funded by the National Lottery Community Fund.

The Operations Manager role is crucial to stabilise and grow the charity. We are looking for someone who is interested in trees and nature and able to manage a small charity.

Support is available from a committed and experienced trustee board who have been managing the charity for the last 8 years.

The trustees have many ideas for how the work of BTP can develop and are happy to fundraise and support projects. Our hope is that further funding will be secured to increase the hours available for staff, to increase the staff team and to undertake more projects.

Our goal is to support the City Council and other organisations in Birmingham to meet the targets laid out in the Urban Forest Master Plan (UFMP).
